The Founder of Millat College



Dr. Syed Abdul Hafeez Salfi
(1916-1999 AD)

The founder of the College Hafiz Dr. Syed Abdul Hafeez Salfi was born in 1916 AD in Darbhanga. He obtained basic education from Madarsa Ahmadia Salfia Darbhanga and was also blessed with Hafiz-e-Quran. After passing exam of graduation from Madarsa he got admission in Medical School Darbhanga and obtained the Medical degree of Doctor. Dr. Syed Abdul Hafeez Salfi was a visionary and man of strong commitment and determination and also was a Muslim Scholar, Leader, thinker, educationist and aware of modern education. After the demise of his father, he was appointed as a president of "Shafi Muslim School". He was one of the pioneer Person who recognized the role of modern education for empowerment and upliftment of Muslim society. He foresaw the imperative need of the Muslims to acquire the modern and scientific education and prepared a road map for establishing a Muslim Minority College. His plans succeeded in igniting the minds of his associates and peers for establishing a college. With strong commitment and support from his associates especially Molvi Abdul Wadud (Advocate), Dr. Hafeez Started transforming his plans into strategy for future course of action.

Dr. Syed Abdul Hafeez Salafi was laid stone of College in the premises of Shafi Muslim School on 17 October 1956. The Congregation ended with the resolution and formation of an Organizing Committee to establish the college namely "Millat College" and Dr. Abdul Hafeez Salfi was appointed as its Founder Secretary. Under premiership and guidance of the founder, the college flourished and progressed rapidly. Dr. Abdul Hafeez Salfi devoted his entire life to the educational advancement and the upliftment of the Muslim Community. He left for heavily abode in 1999, with an indelible mark on Muslims of North Bihar.

Brief History of Millat College

Millat College was founded on October 17, 1956. The foundation and establishment of Millat College, Darbhanga is a result of dedication, conviction and vision of the people, who realized the importance of modern and scientific education of Muslims and built it stone by stone making one sacrifice after another. Millat College started as the first Muslim Minority college of Bihar, founded by Hafiz Dr. Abdul Hafeez Salfi, a visionary and charismatic leader, scholars and educationists who laid stone on October 17, 1956 at Shafi Muslim School, Darbhanga. He also advocated and sought support to start the college, the congregation ended with the resolution and formation of an Organizing Committee to establish the College namely "Millat College".

The College has come a long way from the time of Pioneers envisioned and under took the difficult task for establishing, when only a few enlightened and for sighted Persons were prepared to support the modern education.

The concept of Millat College is derived from the vision of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan was an Indian Muslim reformer, philosopher and educationist in nineteenth century. After that Muslims Community established the educational institutions throughout the length and breadth of the country. The idea of Millat College was conceived out of the growing importance of modern and scientific education, educational backwardness and lack of educational opportunities and access for Muslims of Darbhanga. By the time of independence of India, the Muslim leaders and educationists of Darbhanga had established many institutions for religious and moral education of Muslims, prominent among them were, Darul Uloom Ahmadia Salfia, Madarsa Imdadia, Madarsa Hamidia, Yateem Khana Islamia, Darasgah Islamia etc. Though the first institution of modern education by Muslims of Darbhanga was established in 1932 as a Shafi Muslim School. The dream of higher education institution remained disillusioned for long. It was only in 1956 that the long cherished dream became a reality in form of Millat College.

The first academic year of Millat College started in 1957, with affiliation from Bihar University Patna for I. A. Course and started on lease in the premises of Shafi Muslim School, because it did not have its own land. Prof. Chandra Kant Jha delivered the first lecture on August 5, 1957 in the college. In 1962, the college was shifted to present permanent campus, and got affiliation for B. A. Programme followed by B. A. Honours programmes, I. Sc. in 1964 and B. Sc. in 1967. By virtue of a write petition filed in the High Court the college was declared as Muslim Minority Institution. In 1976, the College came under the control of government of Bihar and became a Constituent College of Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwarnagar, Darbhanga w.e.f. 01.04.1975. The college became a constituent unit of Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwarnagar, Darbhanga in 1975 and recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC)

under Section 12 (B) and Section 2 (f) of UGC Act, 1956. The national Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) have accredited the college with grade 'B'.

In 1988-90 Post-graduate programmes (M. A. & M. Sc.) also were started till 1993-95 when first time co-education started in the college. In 2022 again Post graduate programs in Urdu, Persian and Zoology have been started, Presently more than sixty percent students enrolled in the College are female Students. In 1999, UGC sponsored B. Voc. Environment and Water Management (EWM) programme was started in the college but it was discontinued later due to some technical reasons. The College has again forwarded the proposal to the government for revival the course.

The college celebrated its Golden Jubilee on May 30, 2008 and distinguished alumni of Millat College, Union Minister of State in Human Resource Development (GOI) Janab Ali Ashraf Fatimi presided over the function as a Chief Guest. The college also received UGC constructed Golden Jubilee Block under this scheme.

General rules and Regulations for admission

1. Millat College is a Co-education institution and admission is open for all the Students of Community. The admission is based on the merit through a centralized online admission process. The applications for courses are invited by the LNMU and Students have to apply online on LNMU, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga (Website: www.lnmu.ac.in or www.govexams.com/lnmu/lhome.apax) and choose the College. If the Student is selected for admission in Millat College he/she has to complete the admission process at the College.
 - i. For Master Degree and Bachelor Degree programmes
 - ii. For intermediate Stream Bihar School Examination Board (BSEB) – Online Facilitation System for Students (OFSS).
 - iii. NO separate intimation letter will be sent by the College to the short-listed/selected candidates for admission.
2. Selected candidates shall not be allowed to complete admission formalities in his absent.
3. Candidate not reporting for admission on the stipulated date and time, shall forfeit his/her claim for admission. The offer of admission shall stand cancelled and no correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
4. No candidate shall be admitted unless he/she has completed all the eligibility criteria and required at the time of admission.

5. No candidate shall be allowed to take admission in two Courses /Classes at the same time.
6. Candidate is required to produce his original Marks sheets/Certificates and other supporting documents including the statement of marks at the time of reporting for admission, failing which he/she shall not be allowed to complete the admission, the offered admission shall be cancelled automatically no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
7. A candidate shall be eligible to apply for admission to a course of study if he/she has passed the qualifying examination and also fulfill all other eligibility requirements in terms of subjects studied, percentage of marks, age, etc. The percentage of marks secured by a candidate at the qualifying examination, falling short by even a decimal fraction shall not be rounded off to the next whole number.
8. Candidates enjoying employed status and selected for admission to any full-time course of study in the College, are required to produce leave sanction and/or relieving order at the time of admission from their employer for the duration of the course permitting them to pursue their studies at the College, failing which the offer of admission shall stand withdrawn.
9. The candidate selected for admission shall have to submit the Original Migration and Character Certificates from the Head of the Institution last attended at the time of admission. If a Candidate is not in a position to submit the Migration and/or Character Certificate at the time of admission, shall give an undertaking to submit the same within stipulated time, failing which the College reserves the right to cancel his/her admission.
10. No candidate admitted to a full-time course of study in the College shall accept or hold any employment paid or otherwise or shall be full time student of any other Institution during the course of his/her study at the University except those specifically permitted by the rules.
11. If any error/omission in the processing/verification of Application Form/certificates/ documents/eligibility of a candidate is detected after getting admission to a course in the College, the College has the right to cancel such admission at any stage when the error/ omission is detected i.e., if it is found, at any stage, that a candidate
 - a) does not fulfill the eligibility requirements
 - b) has used fraudulent means to secure admission
 - c) has made false or incorrect statement (s) in the application form
 - d) has not provided his/her signature/photo/thumb impression on the application form or has provided the same of somebody else.

12. In case of cancellation of admission by a candidate, after the closing date of admissions for the concerned course of study, the admission charges/fee of any kind paid by him/her will not be refunded.
13. Reservation rules will be applicable as per government and the University notification.
14. A candidate whose qualifying examination is not recognized by the University/Board shall not be eligible for admission. All such Application Forms/admissions shall be rejected / cancelled.
15. Application Forms shall be rejected if:
 - a) Submitted incomplete.
 - b) Not submitted on prescribed form.
 - c) Submitted without requisite fee.
 - d) Submitted after the last date and no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
16. Candidates got admission in the College must attend the classes regularly and obtain minimum 75% attendance; otherwise he/she will not be allowed to appear for annual/ year-end examinations.
17. Ragging is banned in the College Campus and is a punishable offence as per UGC discipline rules.

- vii. Income Certificate
- viii. Aadhar Card Copy
- ix. Fee for One Year (Fee structure is available in College office).
- x. Exam Admit Card.
